We have analysed at what level the YoPeVa model is realistically deployable in each local context and what the nature of its implementation should be.

These analyses are formed together in National Implementation Plans, which provide information about implementing the YoPeVa model at a **local, regional and national** level of the consortium partner countries. It examined for example the necessary financial resources, alignment with policies on both local as EU level and issues and challenges.
