## Aiming to achieve

**Innovative methodology on youth employment and provide evidence on which programmes are best suited to break the constraints faced by the most vulnerable and disadvantaged individuals in the labour market.**

## Jove Valor, the good practice

'Jove Valor' is a second-chance program aimed at young people not active in education, employment or training, aged 18 to 25, through which they discover and improve their talent through the empowerment and strengthening of their capacities. This great program was inspired by the Brazilian project Jovem Aprendiz developed by the NGO Renapsi and with a duration of more than 27 years.

Jove Valor offers young individuals a one-year paid contract, which combines a formative work process with a professional experience in a welcoming company.

One of the strengths of the project is the support provided by the tutors throughout the project. Their role is to guide, monitor the young people and to be a link between the education provider and the working place.

## Expected impact

- Increasing the employability of young people and contribute towards them having a positive outcome such as gaining a qualification and entering the labour market.
- Introducing initiatives and formal agreements between VET and the private sector that align skills and training opportunities with labour market requirements and sector policies and improve school-to work transitions.
- Increasing the number of social inclusion actions, networks and participants related to or created by young people and women.
